PERKS

To become a WCS school bus driver, you must love working with children, be at least 21 years old, have a good driving history, a current valid driver's license, and pass a drug screen and physical.

Successful applicants will be required to obtain a Class B CDL permit with a P and S endorsement.

Trainees are required to complete the Kentucky State School Bus Driver training core curriculum certification class which is provided on site at the WCS Transportation Department.

Once training is successfully completed and a CDL license has been obtained, the applicant is then placed in the pool of sub drivers. Substitute drivers are eligible for full-time authorized positions as these become available.
